- Oversees all aspects of airfield maintenance and operations, including snow and ice control, equipment **fleet**, paved and unpaved **areas**, public **protection**, runway condition reporting, ARFF, and movement area training in close coordination with all airport stakeholders, and ensures compliance to all Part 139 and 49 CFR 1542 requirements.
- Conducts daily self-inspections, Runway Safety Area inventories and audits forms to ensure operational safety and compliance with FAA Part 139 standards and regulations.
- Collaborates with Airport Project Managers from day one in landside and airside construction projects, reviewing airport layout plans (ALP) and maps, obstruction charts, construction documents, and recommends changes to Construction Safety & Phasing Plans (CSPP) as necessary for operational or environmental considerations. Educates stakeholders on airside safety, and oversees Airside Safety Officers.
- Performs reviews and assessments for airport Stormwater Pollution Prevention Program (SWPPP), Snow & Ice Control Plan (SICP), Safety and OSHA compliance, and Spill Prevention, Control and Countermeasures (SPCC), and Wildlife Hazard Management Plan (WHMP) in coordination with USDA wildlife biologists.
- Oversees majority of Part 139 recordkeeping requirements, and participates in annual FAA Airport Certification audits. Reviews and submits updates to the Airport Certification Manual (ACM), to include reviews of Airport Layout Plan (ALP) as part of Master Plan Update, recommends changes to obstruction charts and includes annual AEP and WHMP reviews and Wildlife Hazard Assessments (WHA).
- Responsible for developing and tracking airfield division operating budget and collaborates with other airport management on overall budget and development of airport rates/fees. Administers and negotiates major fleet purchases, commodities and service contracts.
- Serves as member of Airport Incident Command System team for airport/aircraft accidents, alerts or emergency response in accordance with Airport Emergency Plan (AEP). Oversees and executes annual tabletop drills and triennial full-scale exercises and enacts updates to AEP as necessary.
- Serves as lead for Safety Management System development and implementation in accordance with AC 150/5200-37, in addition to serving as JNU's Safety Committee Chair.
- Closely collaborates with FAA ATO in Juneau to maintain the safest possible surface for all aircraft and ground vehicles. Participates in annual Runway Safety Action Team (RSAT) by providing local, surface-level expertise and follow-through on RSAT action items.
