G. AGENDA TOPICS

1. Discuss Legislative Capital Priorities - Due October 24,

The commission discussed submitting a memo recommending the addition of the Zero Waste Campus to the city's legislative capital priorities, as it was not included on the current list. Members also mentioned the carbon production tracking project and reaffirmed FOG and solid waste as key JCOS priorities. Since additions require support from at least two commissions, JCOS's endorsement of the Zero Waste Campus, alongside Public Works' planned support, could help advance the proposal. Marian moved to submit the memo; Jessie seconded. Motion approved without objection.

2. Discuss outreach session and next steps for EV shipping issues

The commission discussed hosting an outreach session at the end of the month to address EV shipping issues, extending beyond AML's recent policy changes. The event will feature a panel with local car dealers, AML representatives, and city officials for Q&A. The discussion noted impacts on current EV owners, including challenges with warranty maintenance requiring travel south. The commission delegated event planning to the Outreach Committee, in coordination with Renewable Juneau and other partners. Marian moved, Jessie seconded. Motion approved without objection. Steve Benke will serve as the Renewable Juneau point

of contact; Marian will reach out to coordinate. Rose will locate the sustainability session email list for outreach, and Ashley will create a Facebook event.
