- 2. Building Code Advisory Committee (BCAC) - Appointments

The Building Code Advisory Committee is a five member committee with staggered 3-year terms. Committee members, to the extent possible, shall represent the following fields: Architects, Electrical Engineers, Civil Engineers, Mechanical Engineers and Contractors.

There are currently 2 seats up for renewal with terms beginning December 1, 2020 and ending November 30, 2023. Both incumbents, Alan Wilson and Armando Deguzman have applied for reappointment; no other applications have been received.

- 3. Building Code Board of Appeals - Appointments

Per CBJ Code 19.02.010.1; the Building Code Board of Appeals consists of seven members who are qualified by experience or training in matters pertaining to building construction. One member of the board of appeals shall be an architect, one member an engineer, one member an attorney, one member a general contractor, one member a mechanical contractor, one member an electrical contractor and one public member. Members of the board of appeals shall be

appointed by the assembly for three-year staggered terms.

This board only convenes when an appeal regarding a building official or fire chief's decision is being challenged; the last meeting of the board was in June 2015. All boards seats are currently up for reappointment or past reappointment.

After reaching out to members we have 3 that have submitted their applications for reappointment.

The Clerk's Office will continue to reach out to other members of the board to see if they wish to continue on the board and will also continue community outreach to fill any vacancies on the board.

Bradley Austin and Jeffrey Wilson would be reappointed for terms beginning immediately and ending August 31, 2021 and Darrell Wetherall would be reappointed for a term beginning immediately an ending August 31, 2023.

4. Douglas Advisory Board Appointments

The Douglas Advisory Board is a seven member board. Incumbent Joyce Vick has applied for reappointment to the board for a term beginning immediately and ending September 30, 2023.

There are also two vacancies, one with a term beginning immediately and ending September 30, 2023 and an unexpired term beginning immediately and ending September 30, 2021.

On the agenda, the first item under Board Matters has all the applications of members of the public interested in serving on more than one board.

5. Historic Resources Advisory Committee - Appointments

The Historic Resources Advisory Committee (HRAC), created in 1987, is a body of nine members of the community, appointed by the CBJ Assembly, which monitors the historic and cultural resources within the City and Borough of Juneau. The HRAC is comprised of the following: archaeologists, historians, architects, people knowledgeable in the customs and language of the Tlingit and Haida People, owners of locally recognized historic property, people familiar with the operations and issues relating to the city museum, teachers, and the general public.

Incumbent Shauna McMahon has applied for reappointment to HRAC for a term beginning immediately and ending June 30, 2023.

Besides Ms. McMahon's seat, there are two other seats with vacancies each for full terms beginning immediately and ending June 30, 2023. In addition to Ms. McMahon's application there are two other applications - Sarah Hieb and Olivia Lihou.

On the agenda, the first item under Board Matters has all the applications of members of the public interested in serving on more than one board.

6. Juneau Economic Development Council - Appointments

There are three seats on the Juneau Economic Development Council (JEDC) with term expirations as of October 31, 2020. The three seats have terms beginning immediately and ending October 31, 2023. Two of the seats are public seats and one seat is a non-profit environmental organization seat.

The Juneau Economic Development Council interviewed applicants and a memo from JEDC Executive Director, Brian Holst is in this packet with appointment recommendations.

7. Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) - Appointments

These appointments are "housekeeping" items for the LEPC. There are two applications in this packet for appointments to the American Red Cross primary and alternate seats. In February 2020 the members originally appointed to those seats (January 2020) left Juneau and/or the Red Cross shortly after their appointments. Two members of Red Cross have stepped up to fill those seats, Britta Tonnessen for the Primary Seat and Carolyn Garcia for the Alternate Seat.

Both Red Cross Seats are for terms beginning immediately and ending December 31, 2022.

8. Sister Cities Committee Appointments

The Sister Cities Committee is a seven member committee per Resolution 2716.

There are currently three vacancies for various unexpired or full terms on the committee and three applicants. Two of the seats are for terms beginning immediately and ending January 1, 2023; the third seat is for a term beginning December 31, 2020 and ending January 1, 2024.

Chair Bryson was having internet connectivity issues, Ms. Hale took over as Chair whenever Mr. Bryson glitched.

A. Board Matters

A. Aquatics Board - Annual Report

Will Muldoon, Aquatics Board Chair gave an overview of the work the Board accomplished over the last year. The pools were able to keep the budget flat for fees; they did see a lot of turnover of staff then COVID hit and pools were shut down due to hunkering down mandates.

Ms. Hale expressed appreciation for the board and its steadfastness and steady, good communication with the community and the Assembly during COVID.

Mr. Smith thanked Mr. Muldoon for his service and asked if the board was able to track the number of unique visitors and users of the pools over the last year. Mr. Muldoon noted that tracking the metrics this year has been and would continue to be tough. He emphasized the board takes communication with the public very seriously.

Ms. Hughes-Skandijs was excited to see the rec management software switch happening so the pools are able to track use more accurately. Mr. Muldoon said the board receives a use update at each board meeting.

Mr. Bryson asked if the pools have created a good mitigation strategy to prevent a shutdown due to COVID. Mr. Muldoon said, per the CDC and US Swimming its not the pool itself that is the risk but the congregate areas such as the lobby and locker rooms. They want to get it right the first time so they don't have to go back and forth with opens and closures.

Ms. Hale appreciates the pools being open during this time for mental health and physical activity.

Mr. Muldoon closed noting the Assembly will probably see more advocacy for the pools over the next year as the long-term future of aquatics remains uncertain until the pandemic is resolved.

B. Youth Activities Board - Appointments

MOTION: by Ms. Hughes-Skandijs to forward to the full Assembly for approval, the recommendation to reappoint Elizabeth Balstad and to appoint Tom Rutecki and Kristina Moore-Jager to the Youth Activities Board for terms beginning September 1 and ending August 31, 2023 and to appoint Summer Christiansen to an unexpired term beginning immediately and ending August 31, 2022. ***Hearing no objection, motion passed.***

C. Juneau Commission on Sustainability - Appointment

MOTION: by Mr. Smith to forward to the full Assembly for approval, the recommendation to appoint David Teal to the Juneau Commission on Sustainability to an unexpired term beginning immediately and ending June 30, 2023. ***Hearing no objection, motion passed.***

D. Juneau Commission on Sustainability - Sustainability Awards

Gretchen Keiser, Chair of the Juneau Commission on Sustainability gave a refresher on the Sustainability Award proposal and noted it was first discussed within the 2011 Juneau Climate Implementation Action Plan.

Ms. Hale thanked JCOS for its work on creating this award program.

E. Amendments to the Bylaws of the Board of Directors of Bartlett Regional Hospital

CBJ/BRH Attorney Megan Costello was on-hand to answer any questions the committee had relating to the proposed amended BRH by-laws.

Mr. Smith asked for clarification that public process would follow CBJ process in regards to advertising and OMA. Ms. Costello noted, he was correct, BRH follows the CBJ notification process.

MOTION: by Ms. Hale that the Human Resources Committee recommend the Assembly act to accept these by-laws at tonight's Assembly meeting, ***hearing no objection, motion passed.***

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 1116 ESTABLISHING A BUILDING CODE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the assembly is from time to time called upon to modify the technical codes adopted by reference in Title 19, Building Regulations, and

WHEREAS, assembly deliberation on these modifications would benefit from the advice and comment available in the local building community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That paragraph 1 of Resolution Serial No. 1116 is amended to read:

1. There is established the Building Code Advisory Committee which shall consist of five persons appointed by the assembly for staggered three year terms: except, of those first appointed, two shall be for one year terms, two shall be for two year terms, and one shall be for a three year term. The committee members shall, to the extent possible, represent each of the following fields:

(a) Architects:

(b) Electrical engineers:

RESOLUTIONS

- (c) Civil engineers;
- (d) Mechanical engineers, and
- (e) Contractors.

The building official and the coordinating fire chief shall be ad hoc members of the committee.

2. That paragraph 2 of Resolution Serial No. 1116 is amended to read:

2. That the committee shall meet as necessary to review and propose amendments to the building code. The committee shall provide the assembly with an annual report of activities before the end of June of each year.

WHEREAS, assembly deliberation on these modifications would benefit from the advice and comment available in the local building community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. There is established the Building Code Advisory Committee which shall consist of nine persons appointed by the assembly for staggered three year terms; except, of those first appointed, three shall be for one year terms, three shall be for two year terms, and three shall be for three year terms. At least half of the committee members shall, to the extent possible, represent the following interests:

- (a) architects;
- (b) engineers;
- (c) general contractors;
- (d) mechanical contractors;
- (e) electrical contractors;
- (f) plumbing contractors;
- (g) the insurance industry, and
- (h) the banking industry.

The building official and the coordinating fire chief shall be ad hoc members of the committee.

2. That the committee shall meet as necessary to review and propose amendments to the building code.

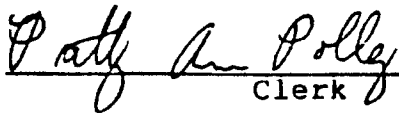
3. The manager shall provide staff assistance to the extent there are funds available for such purpose. The committee shall report its recommendations to the assembly.

TITLE 19 - BUILDING REGULATIONS

Chapter 19.02 - BOARD OF APPEALS

19.02.010.1 - Created; membership.

In order to determine the appropriateness of orders, decisions and determinations made by the building official or fire chief concerning the application and interpretation of the codes, there is created a board of appeals, consisting of seven members who are qualified by experience or training to pass upon matters pertaining to building construction. One member of the board of appeals shall be an architect, one member an engineer, one member an attorney, one member a general contractor, one member a mechanical contractor, one member an electrical contractor and one public member. Members of the board of appeals shall be appointed by the assembly for three-year staggered terms. The board of appeals shall elect from its membership a chair, a vice-chair and a secretary and shall adopt reasonable rules for the conduct of its proceedings pursuant to section [01.50](#). The City and Borough shall provide secretarial and other staff support required by the board of appeals.

19.02.010.2 - Form of appeal.

Appeals shall be conducted in accordance with [chapter 01.50](#), except that if the order appealed from relates to a building or structure which has been determined by the building official to be in such condition as to make it immediately dangerous to life, limb, property or safety of the occupants, the public, or adjacent property and is ordered vacated and is posted in accordance with the applicable section of the International Property Maintenance Code as adopted, such appeal must be filed within ten days from the date of the service of notice and order of the building official.

19.02.010.3 - Limitations of authority.

An application for appeal shall be based on a claim that the true intent of the building codes or the rules legally adopted thereunder have been incorrectly interpreted, the provisions of these codes do not fully apply, or an equally good or better form of construction is proposed. The board of appeals shall not be empowered to waive requirements of the building codes.

All variance requests to IRC 323.3.1 through 323.3.5 and IBC 1612 shall be heard by the Board of Adjustment, under procedures established per [49.70.410](#).

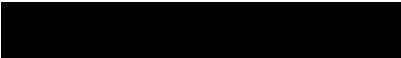

The Juneau Economic Development Council (JEDC) seeks the assistance of the City and Borough of Juneau (CBJ) Assembly to make three appointments to our Board of Directors. In accordance with the Bylaws of JEDC, the membership of the JEDC Board of Directors is comprised as follows:

- The Mayor of the City and Borough of Juneau or the Mayor's designee from the CBJ Assembly;
- The Chancellor of University of Alaska Southeast (UAS) or the Chancellor's designee from UAS;
- One member appointed by the CBJ Assembly representing organized labor;
- One member appointed by the CBJ Assembly representing a nonprofit environmental organization;
- Seven (7) members appointed by the CBJ Assembly based upon their experience and expertise in fields relating to economic development, including but not limited to large and small business, entrepreneurship, natural resource development, tourism, banking and finance, engineering and construction, and government.

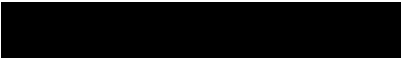

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2716

A Resolution Increasing the Membership of the Sister Cities Committee and Repealing Resolution 2508.

WHEREAS, the Sister Cities Committee has requested that its membership be increased from five to seven members in order to better facilitate the committee's work on its various activities and projects; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on February 2, 2015, the Assembly heard the request to increase membership and directed that this resolution be prepared for presentation to the Assembly for adoption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. Sister Cities Committee.

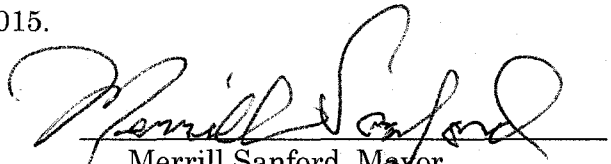
- (a) Committee established. There is established a Sister Cities Committee for the City and Borough of Juneau. The committee shall consist of seven public members appointed by the Assembly to serve for 3-year staggered terms.
- (b) Purposes of Committee. The purposes of the committee shall be:
 - 1. To focus on nurturing the City and Borough's relationships with each of the cities the Assembly has designated as a Sister City, including improving and maintaining the City and Borough's communications with each of its sister cities;
 - 2. To promote and foster mutually beneficial cultural exchanges, international municipal cooperation, and bonds of friendship and understanding between the City and Borough and its sister cities;
 - 3. To provide planning and coordination of activities in relation to the sister cities, including official visits by sister city guests to the City and Borough, and hosting of events for the visiting sister city; the committee may establish subcommittees and ad hoc volunteer groups to assist the committee in these efforts;

4. To make recommendations to the Assembly regarding official visits by the City and Borough to its sister cities;
 5. To make recommendations to the Assembly regarding the establishment of additional sister city relationships;
 6. To periodically evaluate whether existing sister city relationships are achieving their purpose, and advise the Assembly accordingly; and
 7. To perform such other functions and advise the Assembly on such other matters regarding the City and Borough's sister cities as the Assembly may request.
- (c) Procedures. The committee's procedures shall be governed by the Rules of Procedure for Assembly Advisory Boards, as such may be amended from time to time.

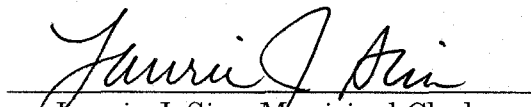
Section 2. Repeal of Resolution. Resolution 2508 is hereby repealed.
