Dave Wood from Arrowhead LP Gas addressed the members of the Committee who were present on LP gas appliance in "pit locations". His main argument was the prohibiting of direct vent appliances in pit locations.

He also spoke of "propane drains" and in-line audible alarms as protective devices.

V. Remaining Action Items

Charlie sent a question to the City Manager and the Assistant City Manager to get their opinions on whether we should ask the Assembly if they are interested in our adoption of the International Energy Efficiency Code.

Charlie resent the subsections 304.1.1, 305.1.1, and 306.1.1(IPMC) to the Law Dept. for their opinion on deletion on 2/14/2012 (9/20/2011). **I heard from Law 9/27/11 that they don't think there is a problem with deleting certain subsections but they wanted to check further into these specific subsections to insure that there aren't any specific problems.**

Revisit Section 412 of the UPC when reviewing '09 IBC.

Doug to research Section 312 requirement to follow procedures in ASHRAE/ACCA Standard 183. Possible Significant Change.

Charlie to check with ICC on removal of exception for under counter dishwashers

Re-review 19.03.903.2.10.1 – Not an SFM modification. Do we want to keep it?

Marquam George has requested meeting with the Committee at some future date to discuss CBJ adoption of the 2012 International Energy Conservation Code.

While editing the IFGC I noticed that Doug had recommended deleting 19.09.304.13 in it's entirety and designing a handout describing method of calculating combustion and ventilation air for cold climates. The design would be engineered.

While formalizing the Uniform Plumbing Code I noticed a note on 19.06.1.412.0 – **Minimum number of required fixtures** – to add to Action Items to “return to section when reviewing the IBC”.

19.03.Table 2902 – Assembly?

ISO discussion – A question has arisen concerning our ISO rating being tied to our adoption of the 2009 or the 2012 IRC. Dan Jager brought up a State Fire Marshal issue which might shed some light on the question. Steve suggested that we ask the Assembly for their opinion. We put any decisions on hold until we receive more information.

Charlie to review Chapter 46 of the IFC and compare it to IEBC requirements.
