	Epidemiology
Move from Phase 1 to Phase 2	Ability and capacity to screen and test widely. Community transmission stable (≤ 4 cases within 14 days), with stable and adequate testing.
Move from Phase 2 to Phase 3	Ability and capacity to screen and test widely. Community transmission stable (≤ 4 cases within 14 days), with stable and adequate testing.
Move from Phase 3 to Phase 4	Ability and capacity to screen and test widely. Community transmission stable (≤ 4 cases within 14 days), with stable and adequate testing.
Move from Phase 4 to Phase 5	Widespread community transmission is no longer present in the CBJ.
