**B. PUBLIC HEARING: Emergency Ordinance 2020-27 An Emergency Ordinance Ordering People to Quarantine When Travelling into the City and Borough of Juneau from Another State or Country.**

This Ordinance which would enact a local 14 day quarantine was introduced and set for public hearing because the Assembly did not know what the Governor would do to update Health Mandate 10, which is set to expire tomorrow on June 2, 2020. On Friday night, May 29, the Governor announced that he would extend Health Mandate 10 until Friday June 5<sup>th</sup> and that he would issue guidance documents today on new protocols which would rely on a level of testing in lieu of quarantine.

The Manager recommends that the Assembly take the following actions:

1. Receive public comments on this Ordinance.

2. Read the Governors new guidance documents.
3. Provide a list of questions to the Manager by Close of Business June 2, so that the Manager can ask for clarifications and answers from the State.
4. Continue this Ordinance until Wednesday June 3.

**The City Manager recommends that the Assembly schedule a Special Assembly Meeting for Wednesday June 3 at 6:00 p.m. to continue consideration of this Ordinance.**
